Regional Coordinator Role Description

Role: Regional Coordinator **Direct report:** Regional Manager

Hours: 2 days per week (15 hours). One set day, one flexible day.

*Initially this role is set at 2 days per week. There may be an opportunity to increase this to 3 days per week.

This role will also require you to occasionally work during evenings and weekends. This will be part of your 15 hours.

Start date: 1st March 2023

Remuneration: \$65k, pro rata 2 days. Plus superannuation. (This equates to \$26k annually and approximately \$500 gross per week)

Place of Work: Coordinators will have a set geographic area to oversee, as well as working collaboratively with other coordinators and the MusicNSW Metro team. Coordinators will work autonomously 2 days per week from a regional location (home office, share office or other agreed location).

Some travel is necessary as part of this role, both within the set geographic area, and other areas of NSW (regional locations and Sydney). All accommodation and travel expenses will be covered by MusicNSW, including modest per diems and petrol expenses. Travel dates will be scheduled in advance, and not total more than 12 overnight stays per 12 month period.

- Represent MusicNSW in regional NSW
- Develop and deliver workshops and networking events for regional industry and artists
- Offer ongoing 1-on-1 consultations for artists and industry
- Work collaboratively as a regional team to support the delivery of inter-regional tours
- Build and maintain regional industry and artist databases
- Complete annual live music censuses for assigned regions
- Facilitate community networking through recommendations, introductions and advice
- Develop the Regional Touring Network website and resources
- Administer social media groups
- Maintain spotify playlists

- Have access to a home office or office space with reliable internet access
